

Managing Your Finances Through Cancer

Did you know that it could take up to five months before a diagnosed cancer patient may start receiving disability payments, which can be 50 - 60% less than their annual income*?

Most patients then become faced with two challenges on top of the already overwhelming diagnosis:

- How to make a lower income work moving forward?
- How to catch up on bills that have accumulated?

During this time frame, cancer care case workers are the central point of assistance to patients and their families. They are faced with financial questions that they are typically not trained to answer. As a result, patients and their loved ones are left to figure out their finances on their own.
